

Privacy statement

SPS International B.V. located at Toekanweg 2, 1118 EB, Schiphol, is responsible for the processing of personal data as shown in this privacy statement.

1. Personal data that we process

SPS International B.V. Process your personal data by using our services and / or by providing it to us yourself. Below is an overview of the personal data we process:

- First and last name
- Phone number
- E-mail address

2. Special and / or sensitive personal data that we process

Our website and / or service does not intend to collect data about website visitors who are below the age of 16 years. Unless they have permission from parents or guardians. However, we can not check if a visitor is older than 16 years of age. We encourage parents to get involved in the online activities of their children, in order to prevent data about children being collected without parental consent. If you are convinced we have collected personal information about a minor without this consent, please contact us via info@SPS.aero. We will then delete this information.

3. For what purpose and on what basis we process personal data

SPS International B.V. processes your personal data for the following purposes:

- To call or e-mail you if necessary to carry out our services
- SPS International B.V. analyzes anonymised behavior on the website in order to improve the website.

The legitimate interest in this is that we must be able to approach you in the context of your contact or information request.

4. How long we store personal data

SPS International B.V. does not store your personal data for longer than is strictly necessary to achieve the purposes for which the data is collected.

5. Sharing personal data with third parties

We can provide the data that you provide to us to third parties if necessary for carrying out the above described purposes. With these parties (processors), we of course make the necessary arrangements to ensure the security of your personal data. Furthermore, we will not pass on the information provided by you to other parties, unless this is legally required and permitted. We may also share personal data with third parties if you give us permission in writing.

6. Cookies, or similar techniques, that we use

SPS International B.V. uses functional and analytical cookies. A cookie is a small text file that is stored in the browser of your computer, tablet or smartphone when you first visit this website. SPS International B.V. uses cookies with a purely technical functionality. These ensure that the website works properly and that, for example, your preferred settings are remembered. These cookies are also used to make the website work well and to optimize it.

You can opt out of cookies by setting your internet browser so that it does not store cookies anymore. In addition, you can also delete all information stored previously saved via the settings of your browser.

7. View, modify or delete data

You have the right to view, correct or delete your personal data. You also have the right to withdraw your consent to the data processing or to object to the processing of your personal data by SPS International B.V. and you have the right to data portability. This means that you can submit a request to us to send the personal information we have in your computer file to you or another organization mentioned by you.

You can send a request for access, correction, deletion, data transfer of your personal data or request for cancellation of your consent or objection to the processing of your personal data to info@SPS.aero.

To ensure that the request for access has been made by you, we ask you to send a copy of your ID with the

request. Make your passport photo, MRZ (machine readable zone, the strip with numbers at the bottom of the passport), passport number and citizen service number black in this copy. This is to protect your privacy. We respond as quickly as possible, but within four weeks, at your request.

SPS International B.V. also wants to point out that you have the opportunity to file a complaint with the national supervisory authority, the Dutch Data Protection Authority.
